For His mercy endures forever.	<b>Day 5</b> <b>1 Corinthians 15:57</b> But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.	<b>Day 6</b> <b>Psalms 106:1</b> Praise the Lord! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

<b>Day 13</b> <b>Leviticus 22:29</b> And when you offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the Lord, offer it of your own free will.	<b>Day 14</b> <b>Psalms 30:4</b> Sing praise to the Lord, you saints of His, and give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.	<b>Day 15</b> <b>Psalms 35:18</b> I will give You thanks in the great assembly; I will praise You among many people.	<b>Day 16</b> <b>Psalms 69:30</b> I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving.	<b>Day 17</b> <b>Psalms 26:7</b> That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving, and tell of all Your wondrous works.	<b>Day 18</b> <b>Psalms 95:2</b> Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.
<b>Day 19</b> <b>1 Chronicles 16:8</b> Oh, give thanks to the Lord! # recipe

## OLD FASHIONED SOFT PUMPKIN COOKIES

### ingredients

2-1/2 c. all purpose flour

---

1 tsp baking powder

---

1 tsp baking soda

---

1 tsp cinnamon

---

1/2 tsp nutmeg

---

1/2 tsp salt

---

1-1/2 c. sugar

---

1/2 c. butter softened

---

1 c. Pure Pumpkin

---

1 large egg

---

1 tsp vanilla extract

---

### glaze

Combine 2 cups sifted powdered sugar, 3 TBSP milk, 1 TBSP melted butter, & 1 tsp vanilla extract & mix until smooth

---

### directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees - grease baking sheets.

Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg, & salt in a bowl, set aside.

Beat sugar & butter in a large mixer until well blended. Beat in pumpkin, egg, & vanilla extract until smooth. Gradually beat in flour mixture.

Place spoonfuls onto cookie sheet and bake 15-18 minutes until edges are firm.

Cool for 2 minutes and then drizzle glaze over the top.

\*for variation, add 1/2 cup chocolate chips to the recipe
